Mission Statement

To publish poetry from any writer that explores community, nature, and the universe.

Ethical Guidelines

The goal is gain the trust of the readers and those who chose to submit their work.

1. We will not charge reading fees for monthly submissions
2. We will not accept money or other favors for publishing submissions
3. We will not pressure submitting authors into subscribing to The Edge
4. We will not otherwise attempt to generate money from submissions
5. We will treat all writers the same and show respect, whether or not we know them
6. We will try to respond personally to each submission received, adding comments if we think it would be helpful
7. We will not prohibit writers from reprinting work we publish as long as we are given credit
8. We will not sell or use any contact information for marketing or other purposes

Submission Guidelines

1. 2 to 3 poems per submission
2. Up to 40 lines in length per poem
3. Up to 3 months for a response
4. A personalized response where we see fit
5. If you have been published, please wait 3 months before submitting again. This will give others a fair chance.
6. Any personal information we collect from your submission is for The Edge's use, will be kept private and, will not be shared or sold to any 3rd party.
